

On October 31, 2008, The Cornerstone Board approved the use of windows in replacement garage doors. Every such installation will require ARC approval before an installation can proceed." For your future convenience, the text of this motion will also be incorporated into the list of permanent Cornerstone Documents that are on-line at CORNERSTONEATTAMARAC.COM.

Homeowners can expect ARC approval when these guidelines are deemed to be met in a homeowner's application to the ARC:

1. The garage door windows cannot be reflecting or partial mirrors
2. The existing house paint style/decor must be preserved when installation is complete.
3. Every installed window treatment shall be muted: A new garage door cannot change the overall appearance of a home.
4. Windows shall be located in a horizontal row near the top of each replacement door.
