Dear Board Members,

As you know, we sold the camper we had since 2004 and have a new camper. The new camper is about 28' in length (about 10 feet longer in length than the old one). The existing variance from July 2004 is for the original camper only. We are requesting board approval for a new variance based on the same conditions as stated in the original variance (see below).

Prior to leaving for a trip:

- 1) Park the trailer in our driveway after 5 PM for the purpose of loading and preparation and to park it over night in the driveway (Ex: Thursday evening)
- 2) Remove the trailer from the driveway by mid morning at the latest the day following (Ex: Friday morning)

Following a trip:

- 1) Park the trailer in our driveway upon return (normally by late afternoon/early evening) for the purpose of unloading/reloading/preparation
- 2) Remove the trailer from the driveway within 3 hours from our return

There could be rare times when we have to do some cleaning and prep work that would require us to park the trailer in the driveway at other times. We do not anticipate the time needed to be greater than a period of 6 hours. We would contact you if there are any other instances.

We have always complied with the terms and conditions of the original variance and have all intentions to continue to comply with the new camper.

We contacted homeowners just to the immediate North and South (Makeem and Maxey) on our side of the street and all three homeowners directly across the street from us (West, Kettler and Kottenstette). All homeowners with the exception of Maxey see no issue with the camper appearing in the driveway.
